"Invisible Frontlines: Human Trafficking Amid Armed Conflict"

13–14 November 2025 | Vienna International Centre + Online

Are you a student or young professional passionate about human rights, global justice, and conflict resolution? Join us for a two-day hybrid workshop and simulation exploring the critical but often overlooked nexus between human trafficking and armed conflict.

This **two-day hybrid event** offers participants an immersive, hands-on experience exploring the dynamics of human trafficking in conflict and crisis contexts. Drawing on simulation models developed by the **OSCE** and **IOM**, the program engages participants in realistic decision-making scenarios through **interactive case** studies, role-playing exercises, and policy development activities.

#### Focus of the Event

In conflict settings, human trafficking flourishes in the shadows. From exploitative labor in conflict supply chains to recruitment via social media in displacement camps, the dynamics of trafficking are increasingly complex and insufficiently addressed.

Participants will take on roles such as UN officials, civil society advocates, government representatives, and private sector actors. Each will collaborate to develop concrete outputs (e.g., legal briefings, strategic plans, advocacy tools) and present them to peers and experts.

- Prior experience in interactive simulations or topics related to human trafficking and conflict is a plus, but not required.
- Multicultural exerience and a commitment to human rights are highly valued.
